DIRECTIONS TO FAUROT FIELD

Enter the West side parking lot (press box side), proceed to ramp on southwest corner of Memorial Stadium. Turn left through southwest gate. A staff member will meet the EMS personnel at the gate.

Ambulance parking for games is in the southwest corner of the stadium.

Home locker room is under the south end zone stands.

Visiting team locker room is under the east side stands in the southeast corner.

Emergency Equipment: Supplies (green trauma bag, red splint bag, black backboard bag, spine board, AED, physician kit) are maintained on the east sideline during games and scrimmages. **An AED is located on the 3rd floor of the Press Box, on the west wall, just south of the elevators.**

**CATASTROPHIC INCIDENT MANAGEMENT TEAM
(CIMT)**

CIMT

- Any catastrophic incident involving a student athlete, staff member, or support personnel.
- The team will be activated to coordinate a response.
- All individual members of the CIMT should be aware of their role and responsibilities.

Guidelines for activation of the CIMT

- Sudden death during competition, practice, or conditioning
- Death during travel
 - University business
 - Personal
- Non-athletic accidents (i.e. home accident, suicide, medical anomaly, victim of a crime)

CIMT

- Disability or Quality of life altering injury.
 - Can occur either in participation and/or travel, or non-athletic related activity.
 - Spinal cord injury resulting in complete or partial paralysis
 - Loss of paired organ
 - Severe head/neck trauma
 - Loss of speech, hearing, sight, or limb

Who's on the team?

- Director of Athletics
- Director of Sports Medicine
- Head Team Physician
- Head Coach of involved sport
- Deputy AD
- Senior Associate AD's (Sports Information)
- Other personnel as deemed appropriate

Immediate Action Plan

- Respect the dignity of the individuals involved
- Notification of parents/guardians
 - Maintain communication with the family, and coordinate travel arrangements
- CIMT will gather all pertinent facts regarding the incident
- Meet with all individuals that may have witnessed or were involved in the incident
 - Document (accurately) all events for legal counsel

Immediate Action Plan

- ALL INFORMATION IS RELEASED THROUGH ONE SPOKSPERSON.
 - Media Relations person or designate
 - No other individuals should speak regarding the catastrophic incident
- Collect and secure all materials, equipment, including but not limited to personal effects, locker, and equipment used by the student-athlete

The Chain of Command

- Director of Sports Medicine notifies or is notified by the Athletics Director, then the following occurs:
 - Notifies the University President
 - Notifies the University Chancellor
 - Notifies the executive team
 - Notifies the NCAA Faculty Representative
 - Notifies the ICA Chair

The Chain of Command

- Notifies Head Coach of Sport
- Designates spokesperson
- Coordinates plan for notification of parents, guardian, and spouse. This may involve Head Coach, Director of Sports Medicine, and Counseling/Chaplain staff.
- Executive Associate AD
 - Notifies Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs
 - University legal Counsel

The Chain of Command

- Notifies the public safety director
- Notifies the Executive AD/Student Services
 - Notifies Academic Advisor, professors
 - Notifies counseling staff
- Director of Sports Medicine
 - Notifies the AD
 - Notifies the Head Team Physician
 - Notifies the Insurance Coordinator
 - Notifies local ministerial support

The Chain of Command

- Head Team Physician
 - Notifies other team physicians, any non-team physician staff involved
 - Communicates with medical personnel, hospital, or medical facilities regarding the incident.
- Insurance Coordinator
 - Notifies NCAA Catastrophic Injury Carrier
 - Notifies the university insurance carrier, risk manager.

The Chain of Command

- Sport Head Coach
 - Notifies the team members and coordinates a team meeting. Encourage the student-athletes to avoid discussing the incident until advised by the AD or designee.
 - Assist in notification of parents, guardians, and spouses.
 - Assist family as needed within NCAA permissible guidelines.

The Chain of Command

- Staff Athletic Trainer
 - Provide immediate medical care and activate the EAP.
 - Arrange for coverage of the site for other participants.
 - Notify the Director of Sports Medicine.
